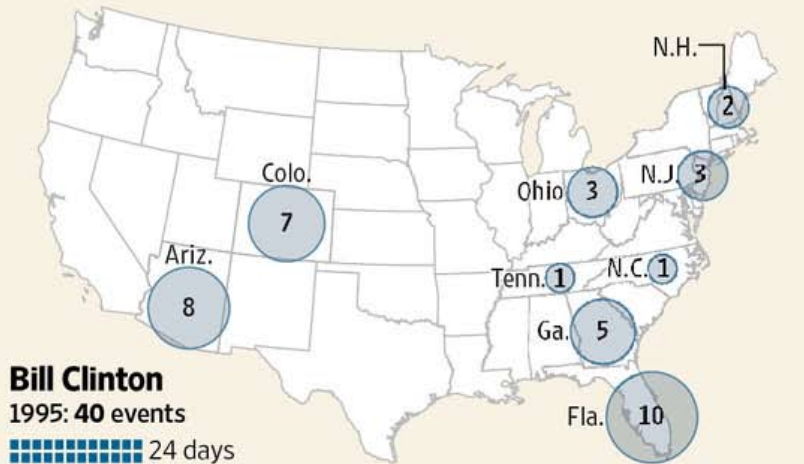


Battleground Travel

THE FACT IS

Regardless of the size of your state, the electoral votes you have, or how much you want your voice to be heard, sitting Presidents and Presidential candidates **won't show up** - unless you live in one a few "swing" or "battleground" states.

This is the result of the current "winner take all" system of rewarding electoral college votes. Out of a total of 300 million voters, **200 million voters are taken for granted**, their state and local parties left to swing in the wind, and their opinions left unheard as the sitting President and Presidential candidates fly over their state on the way to the next "important state."
